KinderConnect – Provider Registration

Providers must complete self-registration prior to accessing KinderConnect. Self-registration is a one-time process for each Vendor ID. The first individual from the Provider organization to register will be associated with the Provider record in KinderConnect and will have the authority to add additional operator accounts after registration.


Account sharing is strictly prohibited; each user must maintain a separate account with a unique username and password. All users are required to set up Multifactor Authentication (MFA) during registration and use MFA when signing in to KinderConnect. The MFA application must be installed and active on the user's personal mobile device. Each account will be linked to the user's MFA application on their phone. When signing in, KinderConnect will prompt the user to enter a verification code generated by the MFA application associated with their account.


Important Notes:

- Install one of the free authenticator apps, such as Google Authenticator or Microsoft Authenticator.

Note: Your Vendor ID is a 9-digit number that begins with 511. You can locate it in the following places:

- Your CCSP Vendor Agreement Attestation Form (signed during the CCSP provider application process)
- Your initial approval letter when you became a Child Care Subsidy Program provider
- A Child Care Purchase of Service Order (POSO)
- Your VA-ECC Provider Portal profile page (note: portal access will only be available until January 5, 2026)

- 5. Enter your first and last name, then create a username and set up your security information and password. Make sure to complete all required fields.

- Must not include special characters

Password requirements:

- Must be between 8 and 15 characters.
- Must contain the required number of digits: 1
- Must contain the required amount of lowercase and uppercase letters: Lowercase: 1 Uppercase: 1
- Must contain the required amount of special characters: 1


